The COM dress code policy has been changed. This change is effective immediately for the class of 2019. The original policy, which can be found on page 133 of the 2015-2016 COM Student Handbook, is updated with the following:

D. Dress Code

See NSU, Health Professions Division section for Dress Code. Only light blue scrubs or professional attire are appropriate in meeting the COM dress code.

See Examination Policy section in this handbook for examination dress code.

Other specific dress code modifications may be addressed in course syllabi (e.g., laboratory dress codes).

Those failing to comply may be dismissed from the classroom and/or the campus and referred to the Student Progress and Professional Behavior Committee. Noncompliance with the dress code requirements may be designated in a student's Medical Student Performance Evaluation.

Please note that the previous dress code policy is still in force for the classes of 2016, 2017, and 2018. This means that students in those classes may still wear an Academeical Society T-shirt in place of the scrub top. No other T-shirts will be allowed in the classroom.
