COURSE DETAILS

Marine Response Awareness Training

Course includes an introduction to the problems associated with marine responses, including jurisdiction, operating in the marine environment, terminology, types of ships and facilities, problems unique to marine responses, tactical considerations, safety, and incident management.

Marine Response Operations Training

Course includes the Awareness Level training, including port organization and resources, vessel familiarization, vessel construction, specialized resource considerations, initial response assignments, incident management, and size-up considerations.

Marine Response Technician Training

Course includes Awareness and Operations Level skills such as tactical response guidance for various types of vessel fires, special resource considerations, stability, and post-incident activities. Detailed tactical techniques for a wide variety of scenarios are discussed, involving a classroom tabletop exercise.

HazMIRTSI training offered meets the minimum requirements of the Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OSHA).
