Policies and Guidelines

About the Award

The CEME Resident Research Award provides five \$1,000 awards to support an osteopathic medicine research project. The CEME Resident Research Award program is open to residents in the Consortium of Excellence in Medical Education (CEME) OPTI member institutions.

Benefits

Trainees will be exposed to research early in their career and hopefully be encouraged to continue research as part of their future training.

Timeline

Application Deadline: September 28, 2015
Award Winners Notified: November 13, 2015

Eligibility Requirements:

- ✓ The CEME Resident Research Award program is open to residents in Consortium of Excellence in Medical Education OPTI member institutions. Applicants must be enrolled and active in their educational program at the time of application and for the duration of the award term.
- ✓ Application submission criteria is met.
- ✓ The research must be completed within 2 years and if necessary awardee can request an extension from CEME's Administrative Office.
- ✓ All awardees must be able to present final summary of their work within 2 years at the next available NSU-COM Residency Fair/CEME Scientific Research Poster Competition.

Application Process

- ✓ Applications **MUST** be submitted electronically to ceme@nova.edu by 11:59 pm, Eastern, September 28, 2015.
 - ✓ Only electronic submissions will be accepted.
 - ✓ The file should be named in the following format: Last name-First name Research Award Application 2015.2016.pdf
 - ✓ Only ONE submission will be accepted. No updates, revisions, changes, or additions will be accepted or considered.
 - ✓ Applications that are not formatted correctly, lack information, have incorrect information, or lack required documents will not be considered.
 - ✓ All submissions **MUST** include all of the information found on the Application

Evaluation, Selection, and Notification

- ✓ The proposed research project's relevance to osteopathic medicine.
- ✓ The quality of the research project.
- ✓ The mentorship available and provided to the trainee.
- ✓ Qualifications, experience, and level of involvement of the trainee for their level of education.

No more than 5 awards will be granted per year.

Individuals chosen for the award will be notified on November 13, 2015 at the NSU-COM Residency Fair/CEME Scientific Research Poster Competition

Award Terms

All awardees are required to submit a one year status report to CEME Administrative Office, unless they have completed their research. All awardees are required present the final summary of their work at the next available NSU-COM Residency Fair/CEME Scientific Research Poster Competition.

No additional monies will be provided for travel expenses.

Research awards are paid directly to the resident. Research awards can be used as needed by the recipient with the purpose of deferring the cost of the awardee's contributions to the research project.
