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With a 955 bed capacity, Mount Sinai Medical Center is the largest private, not-for-profit teaching hospital in South Florida. Mount Sinai offers emergency medicine and internal medicine residency programs. Its Emergency Medicine department treats approximately 30,000 patients annually. Special care units, including medical and surgical intensive care, are supervised by attending physicians and specialty fellows. Mount Sinai Medical Center trains more than 160 residents and fellows in 19 different specialty programs, and offers accredited programs in internal medicine, cardiology, interventional cardiology, pathology, radiology, urology and surgery, as well as an accredited program in podiatry. There are non-accredited fellowships in breast imaging, urologic oncology, and surgical pathology. In affiliation with the University of Miami/Jackson Memorial Medical Center, Mount Sinai has programs in anesthesiology, dermatology, gastroenterology, infectious disease, pediatrics, and physical medicine and rehabilitation. In addition, Mount Sinai Medical Center is approved to train third-year and fourth-year NSU-COM students.

## **Postgraduate Program**

Emergency Medicine Residency is approved for 24 postgraduate Emergency Medicine Residency Positions. The internship year has been integrated into the residency program. The Emergency Medicine Residency Program, as of July 1, 2008, is a four year (PGY-1 to PGY-4) program in Emergency Medicine. The application process is through the Electronic Residency Application Service (ERAS). Applications are accepted July 15 to November 15. Interviews are conducted by invitation from 1st Wednesday in October to 2nd Wednesday in December.
