**CHECK-IN and CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES:**

**Arrive:** Sunday, June 17th, between 1:00 PM and 2:00 PM for local students. Out-of-state students should arrive between 10:00 AM- 12:00 PM, so that we can arrange for transportation (***be sure to send us all of your travel information***). A brief orientation will be held with AIM-HighER parents around 2pm and we will provide light snacks and beverages.

Camp check-in will be clearly marked at the Commons Dorm when you arrive (see address and directions below). Please follow the AIM-HighER signs on University Drive and throughout the campus.

***It is highly recommended that you NOT bring your own vehicle to campus due to limited parking space.*** If your child's vehicle is the only means of transportation, please relay this information to us and ***we will collect the keys at check-in on the first day for safety reasons.***
