

Jamaica Medical Mission Information Sheet

DATES & DESTINATION:

June 2-11, 2018 – Kingston and St. Mary, Jamaica

ESTIMATED COST:

\$1,375.00 (+/- \$50) for the entire trip. Cost includes flight, hotel, ground transportation and ~70% of meals. Price is subject to change since flight arrangements have not been finalized. It is recommended that participants bring along \$150-\$200 to cover miscellaneous cost.

All participants must complete a mission trip application packet. The Jamaica Ministry of Health has several required forms to be completed prior to the mission. Please complete the forms by the requested deadline, so the paperwork can be processed and submitted in a timely fashion.

Please Note: Airline Tickets are non-refundable once they are purchased regardless of the full refund deadline.

PASSPORT IS REQUIRED FOR TRAVEL TO JAMAICA!!

If you do not have a passport, please make sure you go to the nearest passport agency and complete the application in a timely manner. IT WILL TAKE 6-8 WEEKS (sometimes longer) to receive a new passport. If you do not have a passport by the travel time allotted, you will not be able to participate in the medical mission.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: All participants must submit proof of Travel Insurance with their applicable.

Proof of travel insurance is **mandatory** in order for you to participate in the mission. At least \$2,000,000 medical benefits are recommended. Please note emergency evacuation and reparation must be included.

If you **do not have travel insurance** then you can obtain travel coverage from **United Healthcare (UHC) or any other insurance company**. We do not endorse any specific Insurance Company, but have used UHC in the past. They have had very competitive rates, especially for students.
