Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, a portion of the Course Remediation policy has been modified. The modification changes the timeline for taking remediation examinations for Fall Semester courses, **and is only in effect for the Class of 2024**. The applicable portion of the original policy, which can be found on page 121 of the 2020 - 2021 KPCOM Student Handbook, is replaced with the following, with modified text noted in red:

***M1 Fall Semester***

**Courses Taken for the First Time**

Students who are eligible to remediate courses taken for the first time will be scheduled for remediation examinations during the week after the end of the semester, at a date and time specified by the Office of Preclinical Education.

Students who are not successful on one or more of the remediation examinations will be offered a second attempt to remediate by examination ~~during the month of January~~ **in December after all first remediation examinations have been completed**, at a date and time specified by the Office of Preclinical Education.

Students who are successful on the second attempt will continue in the curriculum and will make up missed rotation dates on weekends.

Students who are not successful on one or more second remediation attempts will be subject to dismissal from the Dr. Kiran C. Patel College of Osteopathic Medicine.

**Repeated Courses**

Students who fail one or more repeated courses will be scheduled for remediation examinations during the week after the end of the semester, at a date and time specified by the Office of Preclinical Education. Students who are not successful on the remediation attempt of a repeated course will be subject to dismissal from the Dr. Kiran C. Patel College of Osteopathic Medicine.
