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Magnolia Regional Health Center is a 200 bed acute care facility with inpatient psychiatric unit, a level 3 trauma center designation, provided care for more than 32,000 ER patient visits and an estimated 6,500 surgical procedures (inpatient and outpatient), including CV surgical procedures. We are the largest employer in Alcorn County.

**Our Departmental MISSION is to** Produce skilled, competent, ethical, compassionate physicians through an academically rigorous training program as it relates to the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of diseases, while utilizing osteopathic principles centering on treating the whole person.

## **EDUCATION AND CLINICAL EXPERIENCE:**

Our program provides a structured didactic and rotational calendar. The evidence-based, hands on approach to medical training and education are fully supported by administration, teaching faculty and hospital staff. Magnolia provides a competitive benefit package and loan repayment program with an additional stipend for residents who would like to stay in the area after completion of residency training. Our Internal Medicine residency is approved for 18 spots and we take 6 residents per year. Visiting OMS III and OMS IV students are accepted for specific rotations, along with our core site students. The graduate medical education programs at MRHC prepare trainees for a variety of practice opportunities and/or subspecialty training. Our ambulatory resident clinic serves all payor sources. Residents have approximately eight patients per ½ day per week and clinic patients admitted to the hospital are followed by the residency service. Continuity clinic training begins in the first year of residency. Call—the frequency of call is 1 in 6 for interns along with the utilization of a Night Float rotation for our upper level residents. Please do not hesitate to call if you have specific questions.

We began our cardiology fellowship program July 2012 with two fellows and anticipate taking two each year. Please contact the GME office if you have further interest in our fellowship.

Magnolia Regional Health Center is located in the Northeast corner of Mississippi. We are the only AOA/ACOI approved Internal Medicine Residency in the state.
