Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, a portion of the COMLEX Examinations policy has been modified. The modification affects the Timeline for COMLEX Level 2 CE and PE section of the policy, **and is only in effect for the Class of 2021**. The original policy, which can be found on pages 109-110 of the 2019 -2020 COM Student Handbook, is replaced with the following, with changes noted in red:

Timeline for COMLEX Level 2 CE and PE

- a. Students will first be allowed to sit for the COMLEX-USA Level 2-PE examination after January 1 of their M3 year—provided they have passed Level I and are in good academic standing without probation or restrictions.
- b. It is recommended that students begin scheduling testing dates to take Level 2-PE as soon as the post-January 1 dates are announced.
- c. **Due to the COVID-19 pandemic**, Students will first be allowed to sit for the COMLEX-USA Level 2-CE examination beginning on ~~the last two days of the last rotation block~~ **May 1st** of the M3 year provided they have passed COMLEX Level 1 and are in good academic standing without probation or restrictions.
- d. Students may not take any month as an elective for board study for COMLEX-USA Level 2-CE or -PE during their fourth academic year.
